#### **NEW VACCINE REQUIREMENTS**

Please also note the new vaccine requirements for students in Illinois this fall. Children from Kindergarten to high school will have to show they've has two doses each of rubella and mumps vaccines, instead of one. They must also show that they've had two doses of chicken pos vaccine. A meningococcal vaccine is also needed which is not currently required.
