Parent Responsibilities

Unity Lutheran Christian Elementary School is established to assist you. To take full advantage of this opportunity, *parents are required to be involved with the child’s education:*

- Make sure your child is properly dressed, prepared for school, and brought to school on time
- Have high academic expectations for your child
- Use good grammar at home
- Read to and with your child at home
- Check homework to make sure it is done and brought back to school
- Make tuition payments on time
- Attend Parent Teacher Conferences
- Volunteer 40 hours of service during the school year

School Day

7:45 – 8:00 am	Students arrive, breakfast served

3:15 pm	Students dismissed

On scheduled half-days, students will be dismissed at 11:45 am. Please be on time when dropping your child off in the morning and when picking up in the afternoon.

Supplies

The school will supply the first set of supplies to get your child started. They will need a backpack. Please write your child’s name on it. As the year progresses and as supplies are depleted, you will need to provide some supplies for your child. Your child’s teacher will provide a list for you.

Dress Code

Pants: Khaki Uniform Pants or Shorts, with a belt

Shirts: Burgundy or Gold Polo Style shirt Only – no writing or logos on shirts. Shirts should be tucked in.

Skirts: Khaki Uniform Skirt Should be long enough to reach to the knees when standing.

Sweaters: **Burgundy, Black, Gold, Navy Blue, or White color sweater** may be worn in cold weather. No writing or logos except Unity's logo

HEALTH FORMS NEEDED FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR

Here is a list of medical forms required by the State of Illinois that need to be filled out and returned at registration. These forms should be available in all doctor's offices.

NEW VACCINE REQUIREMENTS

Please also note the new vaccine requirements for students in Illinois this Fall. Children from Kindergarten to high school will have to show they've had two doses each of rubella and mumps vaccines, instead of one. They must also show that they've had two doses of the chicken pox vaccine. A meningococcal vaccine is also needed which is not currently required.
